Early Childhood Music Level I (EC 102) builds on the content of Early Childhood Music, Level I (101). Course participants continue to develop their ability to lead engaging early childhood music experiences, which are responsive to individual and group needs and interests. Additional emphasis is placed on developing musicianship, music lesson planning and curriculum development, implementing successful music teaching strategies, and creating tools to assess students' musical growth. Course participants learn to play beginner pieces on the recorder and piano. Diller-Quaile faculty members visit course participants at their respective day care center to observe an early childhood music lesson.
